

### MACC PROGRAM END-OF-YEAR ASSESSMENT 2018-2019

MAJOR: Master of Arts in Clinical Counseling

### 1. Summary of Assessment Results:

All MACC SLO's were assessed and evaluated over the past year (see chart below). The vast majority of outcome targets were met; however, unexpected challenges to our IT infrastructure prevented us from collecting data on one outcome. Furthermore, in light of our falling short of expectations in regard to two other outcomes, the MACC Faculty remedied the situation by changing our plan of assessment for the unmet outcomes in MCC 530. Instead of one-dimensional multiple choice exams, the MCC 530 outcomes will be assessed through tests that use essay questions that designed to measure both knowledge and skills related to the given outcomes.

## 1. Implications:

As a result of the Alvernia IT infrastructure's inability to process the browser-lock software needed to administer the CPCE and the NCE, the MACC faculty decided to switch over to off-campus testing for the next two years while our IT department remediates the issue with out technological infrastructure. We are also reevaluating all outcomes that are measured by multiple choice exam to determine if more accurate measures can be implemented.

## Alumni Survey and Supervisor Survey Results:

In June of 2019, the MACC Program Coordinator prepared two surveys for distributionone for the 2019 MACC graduates, and one for the site supervisors of the 2019 MACC program graduates. Surveys were emailed to all ten 2019 MACC graduates and their corresponding site supervisors. One alumna responded to the student survey, and none of the site supervisors responded to the supervisor survey. It was therefore determined that these surveys would be redistributed at the end of the 2019-2020 school year, this decision will hopefully yield more fruitful responses due to the larger number of students who will be under site supervision.
